Prize Money

Prize Money will be issued for any stadium record broken during the July 23rd Stadium Buster Meet.

Amount will be will be determined by entry fees collected for that event or by minimum amount, whichever is larger.

50% of entry fees collected or \$100.00 for traditional race distances.

50% of entry fees collected or \$75.00 for non traditional distances.

Wind aided results will nullify prizes.

- Entries must be received by Monday, May 5th for meet # 1 and Friday July 18th for meet # 2 at 12pm (noon).
- Entries submitted after Monday, May 5th and Friday July 18th will be charged double if accepted.
- On site entries on day of the meet will be accepted if there is room in the race sections and will be charged the late
- Please make all cheques to be made payable to "Capital City Track Club"
- Athletes will not be allowed to compete without payment for entry fee. We will not bill clubs for entries.

Email entries will be accepted but Hy-Tek Team Manager entries are preferred and encouraged. Please contact the meet director if email or Hy-Tek is not an option for your group.

- Entry information must include athlete's name, date of birth, AA registration number, club name, and event(s) with current season seed performance(s).
- Payment of entry fees must be made before competition numbers will be released.
- Meet Information will be available on the Sherwood Park Track Classic website www.sherwoodparktrackclassic.ca

Eligibility

- Day of the Meet membership will be available for this meet.
- Out of province athletes must be registered with their respective Provincial Athletics Association.
- All races will be run in open format and seeded according to submitted performances. Meet director reserves the right to verify seed performances and adjust seeds accordingly.

Marshalling Procedure

- For track events athletes may check in at the marshalling table up to 30 minutes before scheduled start time.
- At this time heats and sections may be expanded or reduced/combined based upon checked in athletes.
- Athletes will then report to start line **10 minutes** before the scheduled start time and the start line marshal will then check them in once more, new lane, heat, and or section assignments will be given at that time if changes have been made.
